

WALSALL ARTISTIC ROLLER SKATING CLUB

COACHING POLICY

Definitions:

Coach	An individual approved by the Club Committee as a Coach
Registered Coach	A Coach registered and authorised by FARS.
Assistant Coach	All other coaches.



1. Coaches are appointed by the Club committee and may only be dismissed or censured by the committee.
2. Coaching policy shall be set by the Coaching team who shall be solely responsible for the following:
 - Recommending the Appointment of new coaches.
 - coaching standards.
 - Examination and testing standards.
 - Approving skater's routines.
 - Deciding upon the content of club grades.
 - Issuing invitations to external coaches or experts.
3. The Coaching team may regulate their affairs without interference except:
 - a. If the Committee requires the Coaching teams view on a particular subject,
 - b. There is a dispute between coaches.In such circumstances the Coaching team shall meet formally to discuss the matter, minutes shall be produced and passed to the Club secretary and the issue shall be decided by a simple majority vote of all coaches (registered or assistant) present.

4. The Coaching team's decisions on skating matters shall be final except insofar as they may be called to answer for their decisions before the club committee.
5. No coaching may take place at any skating session unless there is a Registered Coach present. If there is no such coach present then the session may proceed by only as a free skating session and then only if a member of the Committee is present.
6. Assistant Coaches may only coach if a Registered Coach is also present.
