

Restructuring of Classes from 23rd February

When our club started in January 2013, our main aim was to survive! Two years later, we are flourishing with skaters progressing well and membership almost at capacity. In order to ensure we, the coaches are able to continue to serve the skaters, we have decided to re-organise our classes as follows:-

MONDAY - This class will now be for two hours: 6pm-8pm

6.00-7.00pm

– Basic Skills Grade Class - This class will now be for newcomers and skaters who are below Basic Skills 6.

7.00pm-8.00pm

– Intermediate Class – This will be for skaters that have passed Basic Skills 2+ (Current members without grade 2 will be welcome to stay but there is a possibility they will not receive tuition.) Please note: as the hall is likely to be used by another group from 8pm, we would ask that skaters exit the hall a few minutes before 8pm and take their skates off in the corridor.

SATURDAY - This class will now be for three hours: 10am -1pm

10am-11am

– Basic Skills Grade Class (3 Badminton courts) - This class will now be for newcomers and skaters who are below Basic Skills 6.
- Figure Class (1 Badminton Court) – This class will be for those who have passed Basic Skills 6

11am-12am

– Intermediate Class – This will be for skaters that have passed Basic Skills 2+ (Current members without grade 2 will be welcome to stay but there is a possibility they will not receive tuition)

12am-1pm

– Advanced class – This will be by invitation only to any skaters with Basic Skills 4+ who would like to take part in competitions and are committed to working hard. All skaters must be members of the club. For this class to be viable, fees will be charged a half-term in advance and will not be refunded for non-attendance. (e.g. a 5 week half- term would cost £10 paid in advance) Please note: as the hall is likely to be used by another group from 1pm, we would ask that skaters exit the hall a few minutes before 1pm and take their skates off in the corridor.

Please note:

1. Basic Skills refers to the Walsall Artistic Roller Skating Club grades and not the FARS grades.
2. The cost of the classes will remain at £2 per hour for members and £3 for non-members. Skate hire will remain at £1 per session. Please pay as soon as you arrive.
3. All classes run for 1 hour. There will no longer be the option to do half an hour.
4. We would ask that you aim to have skates on 5 minutes before the start of the class.
5. Please bear with us while we implement this new structure.
